School Board Liaison – *Lauren Jasinski*

- We have some good things going on.
- Summer school registration is open and is free to all students.
 Registration closes on May 22nd and will fill up.
- Staff Appreciation Week I have been following along on social media and love what you have done.
- Building updates are going well.
 - We are bringing all the buildings up to date with safety and security features.
 - Addams will get a full overwork.
 - o Each building will have the same security cameras, lighting, etc.
- Elementary schools will be the first to use the new bond money.
 - o Technology first:
 - K-2 students will have a 1 to 1 ratio on touchpad Chromebooks.
 - 3-5 students will have a 1 to 1 ratio on Chromebooks.
 - All teachers will have a new laptop and new docking station.

- Long range planning committee will meet on the 30th at 6:00 pm in the School Board office building.
 - Give input and insight into future projects.
 - This is an important one; they will go over the 4 goal areas.
- Royal Oak Schools Foundation is having a golf outing on June 26th at Metamora Golf & Country Club.
 - Looking to sign up 100 teams.
 - A \$175 entry includes breakfast, 18 rounds of golf, and dinner.
- Trauma informed leadership and education:
 - Shenandoah Chefalo was hired to lead the program.
 - 3-day training course. 2 teams of teachers will go through in summer and all staff in the fall.
 - It is an umbrella approach to good initiatives, DEI, restorative practices, restructuring justice, etc.
 - o Some mental health grants are also helping to cover funding.

 - We need to spend exactly what we make in a year as a nonprofit.
 - We are in a significant net negative.
 - Moving forward with next year's budget, we will need to add more fundraising or cut spending, or both.
 - o Will submit a balanced budget for next year.
- Budget is filed as written.
